





The Housing Society, which made a humble beginning with a mere 76.2 acres of land, has come a long way. This mostly barren land at that time was developed through meticulous master planning, provision of enviable civic facilities and creating quality living environments for its residents. Through planned development over the years DHA has gained a status which now serves as a benchmark for quality community living in Pakistan.

The year 2012 can be termed as a defining period in the perennial history of DHA Karachi as it witnessed a host of development activities specially the DHA City Karachi (DCK) project which is making new inroads and heralding a brighter

future for Karachi. The DCK master plan has been completed in a record period of 12 months followed by the ground breaking of the project thus setting pace for the fast track development of DCK. A proactive strategy to give a new impetus to the fast-track infrastructure development of Phase-VIII, establishment of DHA Suffa University for higher education in the disciplines of engineering, medical and management sciences, adopting a forward-looking strategy for early revival of stalled DHA Cogen Power & Desalination Plant, fixing of Security Cameras at focal locations in DHA for effective monitoring/surveillance of the area and implementation of a new Security Plan for enhancing security in DHA are some of the significant achievements of the Housing Authority which are a sources of pride and accomplishment for the administration.

## **DHA City Karachi (DCK)**

DHA City Karachi (DCK) is an upcoming residential-cum-commercial project on Super Highway spanning over an area 20,000 acres, comprising residential, commercial and mixed use elements. The project is strategically situated at a distance of 35 km from the Karachi Airport and 26

km from the Toll Plaza. DCK has been envisioned as 'The First Sustainable City of Pakistan', which will serve as a model for the future independent cities in the country. The aim is to plan and build a city, which provides its citizens a safe, comfortable, efficient and beautiful lifestyle. DHA City Karachi

holds great promise as a trendsetter project which will be a beacon of inspiration and guidance for others to emulate.

## Infrastructure Development DHA Phase-VIII

DHA Phase-VIII is spread over an area of 4151 Acres of reclaimed land and remained undeveloped since the last three decades. A fresh Master Plan for Development of Phase-VIII was prepared by renowned consultant based on which the infrastructure development is going on at full pace. There are 6 Sectors in Phase-VIII (A to E & E8). In Sector-A & B the infrastructure development works have been completed and the Sectors have been opened for construction. Infrastructure Development of Sector A & B includes roads carpeting, sewerage, water supply, electric works and street lights. Construction of major arterial roads in entire Ph-VIII (RD 03-08) is also completed. Simultaneously development of other sectors including sectors C, D and E-8 is progressing as planned.

## **Information Computer Technology**

Information Computer Technology (ICT) is no longer a luxury but a necessity for large organizations to meet customers' expectations. MIS department at DHA Karachi is executing multi-dimensional role in providing back-end IT support to various DHA establishments as well as taking initiatives for introducing technological solutions for reducing manual work.

Computerization of various DHA departments is also in process. One of the most advanced financial management system is being implemented at Finance Department, this system will be integrated with all other revenue centers to achieve central reporting and business intelligence. Another initiative is to preserve the important documents in digital format; these digital documents are linked with plot system to minimize the physical file movements and retrieval time. With the joint efforts of MIS Branch and Transfer & Record Directorate, a project has been completed where important documents and files of more than 75,000 plots have been digitized.

## **DHA Suffa University (DSU)**

The process for establishing a university for higher education started way back in 2002. Recently established DHA Suffa University, chartered by Sindh Government is being setup at a purpose built campus in DHA Phase-VII (Extension) having state of the art educational facilities. The University has commenced its undergraduate programs in Engineering and Management Sciences with effect from the Fall Semester August 2012. DSU will be a high ranking University of international standard undergraduate providing and postgraduate education in the disciplines of engineering, medical and management sciences in a phased process.

## **DHA Cogen Plant**

The Power and Desalination Plant was established in DHA Phase-VIII astride Arabian Sea on 10 acres of land by DHA Cogen Ltd (DCL) in 2008. The project was envisaged to provide 94 MW gross to KESC network and 3 MGD of potable water to DHA. The project was commissioned with full technological backup of Siemens, Germany and Alfa Laval of Sweden. Alfa Laval provided the desalination units while Siemens Germany provided the state-

of-the-art combined cycle power plant. Later the plant was taken over by AEI which could not run it consistently for more than a year and the plant is non-operational since May 2010.

DHA administration has taken some dynamic and bold steps for the early rehabilitation of the stalled Cogen Power & Desalination Plant to make it functional. Arrangements are in the final stages of planning that would ensure its early rehabilitation / repairs; the plant is likely to be made operational by end 2013.

## **Electronic Surveillance of DHA**

New Security Plan has been implemented in DHA to give enhanced security and peaceful living environment to the residents. In this regard, utilizing most advanced digital CCTV technologies and latest cameras including PTZ and fixed lens, 120 security cameras have been installed at various entrance and focal points in DHA. These cameras are connected through Fibre Optic Cable to Command Centre for effective monitoring/surveillance of the area. Monitoring from two different locations is being executed through 24/7 concept. A Command and Control Centre is established at DHA Head Office under the supervision of Director Vigilance which carries out active monitoring and surveillance of the area and ensures necessary response / actions to deal with any emerging situation effectively.

Under a phased program, DHA is now heading towards a "SAFE DHA" concept, with the aim to have safe and fool proof security environments, through digital CCTV coverage of complete DHA.

### Conclusion

Main role of DHA as a development organization is to provide best infrastructure and facilities to the residents in a professional manner. Today DHA is faced with numerous indomitable challenges at this most crucial stage of its history. However, commitment, resilience and dynamism remain the galvanizing spirit of the Housing Authority with which it is moving ahead. DHA is following a well defined strategy to remain vibrant and a versatile organization showing performance at all the time.

## Central Control Cell: A Facilitator to Fast Track Construction Process

## **General / Introduction**

The present process of approval of Building Plan for construction of houses is complicated and involves a number of agencies/organizations like DHA, CBC and MEO. It is not a convenient process for the residents, and takes lot of time. On the instructions of President Executive Board DHA, a new Central Control Cell (CCC) has been established at the DHA's Main Office where reps of DHA, CBC and MEO would sit together under one roof, to assist the residents in completion of all the requisite formalities. One-window operation would provide a great relief to the residents and drastically curtail the processing time to half.



## Salient Features of CCC

- Central Control Building is ideally located at the front Entrance of Main Office Complex of Defence Housing Authority (DHA).
- It's prime function is to provide maximum assistance and to facilitate residents in completion of formalities for the construction of their residential buildings.
- The concept is to provide a user interface facility with a view to curtail the difficulties and inconvenience faced by the applicants.
- Central Control will entertain proposed Building Plan cases for residential buildings only.
- Representatives from DHA, CBC and MEO will be available at Central Control, so that the delay factor in processing is eliminated.
- A dedicated team headed by the manager at the Central Control Cell will be overall responsible for manning the Centre.

## Case Submission Procedure at CCC

There are separate counters for DHA, CBC and MEO, which would provide all guidance and assistance to facilitate the process.

Once the documentation is found complete, representatives of DHA, CBC and MEO will issue vouchers/challans/receipts for payment which can be deposited at the nearest Branch of National Bank. After availing the Bank Challan from National Bank Branch Phase-I (Near DHA Head Office) the applicant will produce the paid copy of challan/ TR and Pay Order.

Thereafter the case will finally be accepted and a "Case Tracker Number" (CTN) will be issued to the submitter/applicant along with collection date.

## **Sequence of Events**

 Once application for proposed Building Plan is accepted by Central Control Cell it will be

- forwarded to Town Planning and Building Control (TP&BC) DHA the same day.
- TP&BC after carrying out all necessary checking of documents, will further process the case to CBC within prescribed time frame.
- CBC after carrying out all necessary documentation will further forward the case to MEO.
- MEO, after carrying out necessary verification, will sent the case back to CBC for final approval.
- Final approval will be issued from CBC after board meeting. Approved Building Plan will be returned back to Central Control Cell for distribution to the applicant.

## **Case Tracking Procedure**

- CTN will be the ID of every case submitted at the counter of the Central Control Cell. It will be the responsibility of Central Control to monitor the proceedings of cases, within the time frame. Manager CCC will keep monitoring the cases on daily basis.
- All accepted cases will be packed under a special designed envelop for each Department along with its CTN
- Once the proposed Building Plan is accepted and

- approved, it will be delivered to the applicant at CCC.
- During this entire exercise, Central Control will follow the cases right from beginning. If any delay from any Department is found, the Team Leader will inform concerned member or Head of Department to take corrective action.

## **Delivery of Cases**

The owner / applicant will visit Central Control Cell for the collection of its documents on due date. Counter staff after verifying the identity of the individual will ask for the collection receipt, Case Tracking Number and CNIC (in original). After ascertaining the identity, the staff will deliver special sealed packed envelope of Approved Building Plan to the individual concerned.

## Steps Required for Construction of Residential Building in DHA

Owner/transferee of plot in DHA are required to acquaint themselves as how to start the construction of their residential house or commercial building. A new concept of ONE WINDOW OPERATION is being introduced to facilitate the owners. A guideline in this regard is given for your better understanding which will facilitate for planning of construction of building.

## Step 1 Issue of Site Plan

It is the first major documents required for the planning to construct a building. For issuance of Site Plan following documents are required.

- Photocopy of Allotment Order/Transfer Order/ Mutation/Division.
- Photocopy of CNIC of owner.
- Photocopy of Payment Receipt.

On the prescribed date, the Site Plan can be collected either personally or through Registered Post from TP & BC Dte .

## Step 2 Execution of a Lease

Sub Lease 'A' entitles an allottee/transferee of residential/commercial plot the permission to commence construction after the approval of building plan. Owner has to apply for Execution of Sub Lease 'A' on a prescribed form issued from DHA Lease Branch and submit alongwith following documents:-

 Application to the Administrator requesting Registration of Sub Lease 'A' with full particulars of the owner.

- One latest passport size photograph.
- Two photocopies of owner's CNIC and two photocopies of each witnesses.
- NO DEMAND CERIFICATE from Finance Dte DHA (Original).
- One photocopy of Almt/Tfr Order/Division Order
- Receipt of purchase of Construction Bye-Laws from DHA after the payment of Rs 300/-.
- One copy of Site Plan issued within last two year.

## Step 3 Submission of Building Plan

It is the Plan prepared by the owner through the DHA's authorized architect

### **Procedure**

After receiving the Site Plan and execution of Sub 'A' Lease, owner will get the building plan prepared through DHA'S APPROVED Architect and submit Building Plan to CCC with the following documents:-

- Application address to Dir TP&BC for submission of Building Plan.
- Application form A & B issue from Cantonment Board Clifton (two copies)
- Photocopy of Allotment /Transfer Order/ Amalgamation/ Division Letter.
- Seven copies of Building Plans including one cloth mounted alongwith detail of Underground, Overhead, Septic and Grey Water connection tank and garbage collection chamber.
- One Soft Copy on CD of Building Plan duly prepared in Auto Cad format.
- Seven copies of Site Plans (Ammonia Print) issued by DHA Authority (Valid for 2 years)
- Two photocopies of CNIC
- Photocopy of Sub Lease 'A'
- DHA fresh transfer history letter to be issued from DHA Tfr&Record Dte.
- Indemnity Bond on Rs 100/- stamp paper duly attested by Notary Public for Basement.
- Undertaking & Form 'C' on Rs 200 Stamp Paper.

## **ABOUT DHA**

After submission of documents at Central Control Cell, the applicant will be given a tentative date of collection of approved building plan/NOC from the Central Control Cell. After approval by CBC, the Building Plan is handed over to owner or his attorney alongwith approval Letter for carrying out of construction within two years extendable for another one year.

## **Step 4 Issue Of Demarcation Letter**

It is physical possession of the plot by the allottee/ transferee which is handed over by DHA. Staff of TP&BC Dte indicates the location of the plot. The owner will then construct concrete boundary pillars at the corners of his plot which are checked by DHA TP&BC Dte and after verification Demarcation Letter is issued to allottee/transferee

## **Procedure**

- Application address to Director TP & BC for issuance of Demarcation Letter.
- Photocopy of slip of Sub Lease 'A' issued from Sub Registrar Clifton Town-I.
- Photocopy of Allotment/Transfer Order/ Amalgamation/ Division Letter.
- Photocopy of Approval letter of Building Plan
- One copy of Site Plan Ammonia Print issued by DHA (valid for 2 years)
- Photocopy of CNIC of allottee/transferee.

After submission of documents, owner is requested to visit additional director planning to sign papers and obtain date of handing over of plot on ground.

## Step Issue of Nocs at Various Stages

The process of NOC is carried out to check/ verify that either construction is carried out as per approved building plan. It will facilitiate the allottee/ transferee to rectify in time any violation against the aproved building plan which not only create problem on the submission of completion plan but also save the allottee/transferee from payment of huge financial penalties for the regularization of any violation.

### **Procedure**

- During construction apply to TP&BC Dte for the issuance of NOC's by submitting photocopy of approved Building Plan.
- Certification of Approved/Licensed Structural Engineer on Form-5 at various stages of completion.

- Stair Tower (if constructed)

## **Step 6 Submission of Completion Plan**

After completing the construction of building the allottee/transferee will submit Completion Plan on Form-6 as per approved building plan for the purposes of obtaining approval and occupancy certificate.

## DCK Curtain Raising Seminar

## Unveiling the awaited dream

he Curtain raising seminar of DHA City Karachi (DCK) was held at DHA Golf Club Convention Centre. The seminar was organized to unfold the salient features of DCK Master Plan along with its development strategies. Ex-Commander 5 Corps Lt Gen Zahirul Islam was the chief guest.

The seminar was inaugurated with the welcoming address by Ex-Administrator DHA, Brig Aamer Raza Qureshi. While highlighting the objectives of this well planned project, the Administrator termed DCK as the first planned, sustainable and green city of Pakistan. He said that a consortium of leading national and international firms like Doxiadis Associates (Greece), RMJM (UK) and Osmani & Company prepared the DCK master plan in a record period of one year, thus setting the pace for development of the most modern city of Pakistan. He added that DCK would be made a livable entity in 3-5 years, by implementing a development strategy comprising an Immediate Action Plan to make DCK site operational (2011-2012), Short Term Development Plan encompassing primary infrastructure/facilities development (2012-2015), Mid Term Development Plan (2015-2020) and Long Term Development Plan for completion of the entire project (2020-2030).

Chief Concept Advisor DCK, Dr Spiro Pollalis highlighted that the DCK master plan maintained the

natural topographical beauty of the area by carefully adjusting the housing and other land uses according to the terrain. He added that the entire master planning scheme consisted of sixteen residential sectors within DCK planned as mini cities which will provide all the residential/communal facilities at a distance of 5-20 minutes walk.

Engr Arif Osmani, DCK Project Leader talked about the urban development and how ingredients such as mixed use districts, neighbourhoods, green spaces, community facilities, educational centers alongwith sports arenas, theme park, efficient transportation system and sustainable housing etc constitute the quality that will weave DCK's urban tissues.

Professor Dr Kodylis, highlighted the Business Opportunities of DCK that would encourage economically driven development by providing a variety of facilities such as business infrastructure and work opportunities for its residents. He added that apart from the city wide-functionality, an international business approach had been planned in DCK Downtown District where business activities would be hosted with maximum safety.

DCK Project Dir, Brig (R) Rafique talked about the balloting which would be held soon for allotting plot numbers to 27,000 plots owner.

Ex-Commander 5 Corps and President Executive Board DHA Lt Gen Muhammad Zahirul Islam was the chief guest. The ceremony commenced with a welcome address by the Project Director DCK Brigadier (R) Muhammad Rafique, he said that the ground breaking of the project was strictly on schedule thus setting the pace for speedy development of the first planned, sustainable and green city of Pakistan. ## **Brain Storming Session**

he Annual Director's Conference was held at DHA's Main Office. Ex-Administrator DHA gave a rundown on the performance of DHA during the last one year and highlighted that the major focus of DHA had remained on Mega Projects, Cogen Plant, Development of Phase-VIII, Master Planning of DHA City Karachi and on addressing residents problems.

As regards Mega Projects, he said that most of those were non-performing projects and are a source of concern for DHA as well as those who had made investments as allottees. DHA followed a policy which envisaged engaging the developers in positive negotiations to encourage them to start/

complete the project, failing which; steps were to be taken to eliminate non performing developers. Despite assurances, the developers did not respond and as part of its decided policy, DHA has taken possession of three Mega projects through court orders.

Development of Phase-VIII is steadily progressing and shall gain further momentum when additional 1-2 sectors of Phase-VIII will be tendered for development. He said that DHA City (DCK) project is also on track and its master planning had been completed in time by the consortium of International/National consultants.

## **Impressive Development Profile**

antonment Board Clifton and Defence Housing Authority work in harmony, sharing a mutual and primary goal of providing the best possible living environment to the residents. Essentially, DHA is a development authority responsible for carrying out land usage planning and infrastructural development, whereas CBC is a service provider that assures provision of municipal services and maintenance of civic infrastructure in the developed phases of DHA. It has been experienced that most of the residents / members are unaware of the respective domains of DHA and CBC and therefore, do not approach the right agency for their problems.

It is important to understand that these are two separate organizations which function independently. This separation is effective since 2010 and was done by Ministry of Defence, due to strong desire of the residents. For the convenience and better understanding of our valued residents, some of the major municipal functions are listed below, for which they need to interact with CBC:-

- Distribution of water
- Maintenance of roads, street lights, traffic signals, parks, sewerage system, commercial areas, empty plots and all maintenance related works
- Cleanliness including garbage collection / disposal, bush cutting etc.

However, in Phase-VIII most of these functions are still being performed by DHA as it is not fully developed.

## Infrastructure Development of Phase-VIII

Infrastructural development works in DHA Phase-VIII are being done on a fast track basis and as per the timelines set forth. Two to three sectors of Phase-VIII will be opened for construction of houses in next one year. Rest of the major works will also

be completed in next 3-4 years. However, this calls for support from the members / allottees. They are requested to clear their all outstanding dues so as to assist DHA in timely construction of all projects.

## **Development of Ph-VII Extension**

Comprehensive and detailed master planning of DHA Ph-VII Extn has been completed and infrastructure development works of the area will commence soon to provide all requisite civic facilities to the residents. This would enhance the property value and significance of the area.

## **Water Front Development Projects**

Concerted effort was made to revive these projects failing which DHA land was repossessed in most cases through the help of Court. Revival of Emaar Project is likely in near future. DHA remains committed to give top priority to the concerns of allottees / effectees, while handling these projects.

## **DHA Cogen Project**

Water made available by KWSB is distributed by CBC to DHA residents while DHA had been working on revival of Cogen Plant to ensure availability of additional water. The process was complex and entailed dealing with numerous stakeholders. Lately, the rehabilitation process has started rolling and the

plant will be functional by mid 2013 after necessary repairs.

## DHA City Karachi (DCK) Project

DHA City Karachi (DCK) is a prestigious project of DHA on Super Highway. The Master Planning was completed in September 2011 and the Ground Breaking of the project was done in February 2012, as per laid down timelines. Preliminary works on the site commenced in Jan/Feb 2012. Sector Development will start in early 2013. Balloting of plots is also planned in the current year. All the members of DCK are requested to clear their outstanding dues to avoid surcharge and to ensure speedy development works which will ultimately benefit them in terms of enhance property value (already an increase of 30-40 % in prices has been noticed in last 8-10 months).

## **New Graveyard in DHA**

To redress the urgent need of a new graveyard, DHA is planning to construct a new graveyard, in Defence Phase-VIII at the earliest. After approval by Executive Board the work on construction of new graveyard would be undertaken speedily.

## **Street Lights**

This aspect was given special attention by CBC. Replacement of 105 rusted electric poles along with allied accessories on Beach Avenue is being executed on BOT basis. Almost 4000 light poles have been illuminated by CBC in current year.

## **Security & Surveillance in DHA**

Defence Housing Authority has formulated a new Security Plan in DHA to improve the security. The plan will be implemented jointly by Rangers, Police and DHA Vigilance. The plan includes random checking of vehicles for

- Carrying non-registered weapons,
- Narcotics / Contra bands
- Explosives
- Fake motor registration
- Vehicles with tinted glasses

Display of weapons in DHA is prohibited and this restriction will be strictly enforced by a joint team of

LEAs who will randomly check such practices.

The Housing Authority has also planned electronic surveillance of the entire DHA which will be implemented in phases. In Phase-I of the plan, all entry/exit points of DHA are being monitored through cameras from a Control Room, appropriately linked with suitably located LEA teams for quick reaction/response to any unwanted activity noticed. 260 more cameras are being added in phase-II of the programme, furthering the aim to attain safe and secure environment.

## **One Window Operation**

At present the process of approval of Building Plan for construction of houses is complicated and involves a number of agencies/organizations like DHA, CBC and MEO. This involves a lot of time wastage and is not convenient for the residents. On the specific instructions of President Executive Board DHA, a new Central Control System is being established at Head Office DHA where reps of DHA, CBC and MEO would be sitting together under one roof to assist the residents in completion of all the requisite formalities. One Window operation would provide a great relief to residents and drastically curtail the processing time to half. The Centralized Control would be functional in a couple of months.

### Conclusion

Comfort and convenience of residents has always remained top priority for DHA, which makes concerted efforts to provide the best housing and residential facilities to the residents. Participation and co-operation of residents is of vital importance in making this effort of DHA workable. Feedback of residents and their suggestions for betterment of projects/development scheme would help DHA to make its policies effective and resident-friendly. The issues of general maintenance of the area being a municipal function are being looked after by CBC. However DHA's facilities and support for CBC would always be there to supplement its efforts. Both organizations are working in unison for achieving the common goals of making DHA a secure, safe and comfortable living place.

Security threat is one of the grave issues which Karachiites are always confronting. Psychologists have proved that ideal residential places are those, which offer "Peace of Mind". Here at DHA, utmost effort is made to transform this residential estate into "Secure Heaven" so that the dwellers could float freely at-least in the vicinity of DHA.

DHA claims the responsibility of its inhabitants and constantly strives to provide secure environment to them. In this regard the new administration has introduced "DHA-Security and Surveillance Project" for the safety of its habitat. Surveillance System has been installed in DHA, which covers all entry and exit points through 120 cameras. Latest state of the art cameras including PTZ and fix lenses have been installed. Monitoring is being done through advanced digital CCTV technologies. The system has enough capacity to record footages from two different locations by following the 24/7 concept.

A Command and Control Centre has been established at DHA Head Office under the supervision of Director Vigilance to address complains launched by the residents, the centre is working on the "Call Centres Concepts". Soon all echelons of security will be incorporated into

this system such as LEAs, fire stations, hospitals, emergency services provider etc.

In the second phase, 260 more cameras are planned to be added, furthering the aim to attain safe and secure environment. These cameras will be installed at all commercial areas, public places including educational institutes, parks, mosques and imambargahs. "SAFE DHA" concept will be attained by electronically covering the whole of DHA.

In the near future Vigilance Directorate will employ ANPR (Automatic Number Plate Recognize) system in DHA to facilitate traffic control and to minimize vehicle theft case.

## Efficiency through automation

n the year 2012, the focus of MIS department remained on computerization of DHA Clubs. The clubs have been equipped with standardized modules inclusive of unlimited Human Resource, Payroll, Procurement, Inventory, Members Management, Restaurants Management, Rentals, Billing, Point of Sale and Financial System etc. All these modules are centrally controlled from DHA Head Office.

Computerization of different DHA establishments is also in full swing, some significant IT projects completed successfully by MIS Branch in the year 2011 are highlighted below:

## **SMS Payment Acknowledgement**

For DCK Plot Owners, Finance Directorate posts all the DCK payments received into the payment recovery system. SMS confirmation alert is generated for the members to confirm the receiving of payments along-with amount and receipt number.

### **DHA Medical Center System**

Medical Centreis now managing patients according to their prescriptions, medicines purchasing, inventory and issuance as per prescriptions via software. The center is linked with personnel branch and health insurance dept to retrieve employee's data.

### **Education Institutions**

In house developed student billing system has been executed in DHA Main Education Institutions. DAEI's will now be able to manage student's registration and monthly fee billing generation by using this software. Also fee defaulters can be identified and then letter may be generated accordingly.

## **WAN Connectivity**

DHA Offices have been connected to the Head Office and can share email system and other

services. Radio poles and devices have been installed; connectivity configuration and firewall setup have been done.

## **Software for Computer Workshop**

All computer repairs/trouble shooting complaints are logged in the system, gate passes, and billing summary generated via this system

## **Queue Management System**

To facilitate DHA residents, a system with token dispenser, display counters as well as voice calling of token numbers has been setup for Membership and Property Transfers matters.

### **Computer Generated Transfer Orders**

Transfer Order preparation and printing has been digitized where, pictures of purchaser and sellers along with family details of purchaser on security enabled papers are computer generated.

## **Monitoring Desktop Console**

An integrated statistical web based screen is provided to management, where important summary of transactions of DHA Departments can be monitored in real time.

## **Vehicles Management System**

This software will help MT & Workshop Branch to record and manage vehicles, its procurement, insurance, repair / maintenance, oil / lubricant inventory and proper reporting of all DHA vehicles.

## **Financial System**

Oracle Financials system has been declared GO LIVE and is running successfully in parallel with legacy system at DHA Head Office Finance Directorate. Account Payable, Account Receivable, Cash Management and GL processes have been automated as per the requirements.

evenue collected by the Government are used to provide basic facilities to the public which includes provision of healthcare, social security, national defence, free education, public and many other social services. The significant portion of the Government's revenue comes from various direct and indirect taxes paid by the individuals and organizations.

Despite the fact that the Government has huge machinery for tax collection, the significant part of taxes is collected by the taxpayer being withholding agents. Further, indirect taxes (e.g. Sales Tax) are collected through agents as designated by the Government and through registered sales tax persons.

DHA besides paying income taxes on its income and sales tax on services is also a big withholding agent collecting taxes from suppliers and employees.

DHA deposited Rs. 674 million in last five years as withholding tax and Rs. 100 million as Sales Tax collected from various suppliers and vendors.

## DHA City Karachi - Sustainable Master Planning & Infrastructure Design

HA City Karachi (DCK) is proposed to build over an area of 11,640 acres. The land is projected to accommodate more than 600,000 people. Approximately thirty thousand plots have been sold whereas 20,000 more plots will be made available in future ballots. Master planning had been started from September 20, 2010 in collaboration with one of the oldest consulting firms of Pakistan Osmani & Company (Pvt.) Ltd. More than 100 professionals from throughout the world worked on the DCK Master Plan, and this task was completed in record 12 months in September, 2011.

The major sustainable feature of the DCK Master Plan is its entity as a complete city, offering jobs and employment that will reduce the requirement of daily trips to Karachi. DHA City is not just a subdivided land or a housing community, but It is envisioned to be a modern Pakistani City of 21st century, having facilities and amenities that DCK has planned to deliver like sport centers, theme parks, golf course, efficient transportation system and residents safety.

Quality of life is one of the distinguishing features of DCK Master Plan. Unique landscape of DCK city is ideal to provide a variety of parks, dispersed and interweaved recreational facilities with a pleasant view and convenient access. One of the most important factors that determine the high quality of life within the urban framework of DCK is the value of diversity. DCK aims to draw the guidelines for this value, by being simultaneously a city intimate for its residents and a city-platform for holding different functions and events of visitors and

users. The Ingredients such as mixed use districts neighbourhoods, green spaces, educational centers together with sport centers, theme parks, golf course, efficient transportation system and pedestrian safety, traditional market and sustainable housing etc, collectively constituents the quality that will weave DCK's urban tissue.

## **Neighbourhoods & Proximity Concept**

DCK has derived a plan where dwellers will comfortably share their lifestyle further enabled due to interlink social proximities. Sixteen residential sectors have been planned in DCK whereas each sector is almost an independent small city of approx. 40,000 residents. Renewable energy sources including solar, wind, biomass besides waste-to-energy shall play key role in Energy strategy of DCK. SMART Grid based integrated systems have been finalized for DCK, heralding a new age of SMART cities in Pakistan.

Special focus is being maintained on water supply, sewerage, drainage and solid waste management of the DHA City area. Detailed requirements are worked out for the water demand of the estimated future population, the natural slopes on the site are utilized for drainage flows and two major lakes are proposed to be developed in order to accumulate the local streams' surface-runoff for various uses. A sustainable sewerage collection & treatment system has been planned to efficiently collect the sewer loads by planning as per topography of the land, and then treatment and reuse of this resource for beneficial usage for irrigation and ground water recharge.

The existing and proposed future transportation infrastructure network connecting to DCK are being analyzed and planned to connect the whole Eastern Karachi region (including DCK) with central Karachi. A number of initiatives are in different stages of feasibility studies including construction of Malir River Expressway, Integration of Karachi Circular Railway & Mass Transit Corridors with DCK, and Integration of DCK with nearby Education City.

The completion of DCK Sustainable Master Plan will result in initiation of first Green & Sustainable city of Pakistan, which will provide a new lifestyle for the people of Karachi & Hyderabad.

The city therefore would operate with less energy, part of which will be generated on site from low-carbon and renewable energy sources (solar, wind, biomass). 30% of power requirement in DCK would be met through renewable energy for which space for solar and wind energy parks have been dedicated in the area and leading renewable energy companies

## Salient Features Enriched With Natural Beauty

Series of efforts have been made to maintain the natural topography of the area in addition to maintaining a safe and clean environment. Parks, lake and bird aviary are only some out of the various approved plans so that future residents live and breathe in an entirely healthy atmosphere.

### **Sophisticated Transportation Network**

A highly structured transportation network has been mapped out to facilitate the residents.

Two main roads will provide rapid access to the entire site, minimizing the distance of any point from the Superhighway and allowing the development of vital activities beyond the frontage of DHA City Karachi.



Anorth-southroadwayconnects the Superhighway with the farthest southern area and an east-west roadway connects the newly planned developments with DCK.

Malir River Expressway is in planning stage, on completion it will amazingly reduce the travelling time from the metropolis to DCK to 30 minutes thus shrinking the distances.

#### Safe & Secure Abode

DCK Health City including a Medical College and a teaching hospital will ensure provision of state-of-the-art health care facilities to the residents. Additionally, there will be primary care clinics in each residential sector along with a secondary health care complex in the Southern Zone.

#### **Trends in Plot Prices at DCK**

However, the current market trends show large increase in the plot prices in the open market even in this current recession. An increase of 30-40% in prices has been noticed in last 8-10 months. ### Working towards interests of rightful owners

#### **DHA Cogen Plant**

In Order to meet the future needs of Water & Power primarily for the planned Highrise Residential & Commercial Complexes and also for Phase-VIII, DHA conceived the establishment of Power & Desalination Plant of 90 MW Power & 3 MGD Water in Phase-I and subsequently Cogen Plant of 150 MW Power & 5MGD Water in Phase-II. The Plant was commissioned, with full technological backup support of Siemens Pakistan, Siemens AG Germany and Alpha Laval of Sweden in February 2008. Alpha Laval provided the desalination units while Siemens Germany provided the state-of-

the-art combined cycle power plant. DHA Cogen Plant operated for 11 months only and that too in brief spell of 2-3 months and the Plant is lying closed since May 2010. The effort to revive the plant commenced in September 2010, followed by negotiations with board of directors of DCL, AEI, the banks and minority shareholders. A positive headway has been made in this regard; hectic efforts are going on to make the plant operational at the earliest.

Third Party Evaluation and Route Cause Analysis of the plants were under taken by Siemens and



Fitchner both German Firms. The report is very encouraging and implies that Cogen plant could be made operational with requisite repairs. A significant headway has been made towards revival and rehabilitation of the non-functional Cogen plant. A new management would soon take over the administrative/operational control of Cogen project and would ensure speedy completion of comprehensive repairs/rehabilitation of the plant. The new arrangements will enable DHA to have adequate representation in the Cogen Board to ensure uninterrupted/smooth operation of the plant in future.

All the stake holders of the project are

supporting the new management which would arrange necessary funds for carrying out the repair/maintenance of plant, while various tariff agreements with NEPRA, KESC and CBC etc are being finalized and the Cogen plant is expected to become fully functional by end of 2013.

### **Crescent Bay Project**

This mega project was a joint venture between M/s EMMAR Dubai and M/s GIGA Pakistan and DHA. The project was estimated to be completed by 2010-11. The projects is spread over 108 Acres land reclaimed by Developer, comprising 46 x 30 storey buildings. Agreement was signed with DHA in 2004, land was leased in 2005.

With hectic negotiation with developer, a new master plan has been made and the stalled project is restarting shortly. Developer will completely implement the revised master plan upto year 2022 and will also construct waste water / sewerage treatment plant to meet the hygienic and environmental standards of the coast line. Necessary arrangements have also been made to ensure that customers interests are looked after by the Developer and necessary compensations will be made in case of any delays.

#### **Creek Views & Terraces Project**

Famous property developer AKD Group in a joint venture with DHA will launch Creek Views & Terraces project. The project is spread over 43 Acres Land, comprising 14 Residential Towers (18-28 Storey) and 3 Office Complexes. Agreement was signed with AKD in July 2006, while land was leased to project developer in July 2010. Project Office and model apartments are under construction and soil testing is being carried out along with piling work. Presently the Developer is using his own resources for the construction and all other activities to build confidence and develop trust of the customers. Project is expected to be launched to the public by the Developer in July/August 2012.

### **Creek Marina Residential Complex**

The project was launched by M/s Meinhardt, Singapore as a prestigious residential complex in Phase-VIII. The project is spread over 19 Acres of Land, comprising 8 x 27 Storey Residential Towers. Out of 768 Apartments, 256 Apartments were sold. Agreement was signed in September 2004 and land leased to project in May 2005. The Project got stalled. Presently negotiations are being concluded with the Developer for putting in place the arrangements for the revival and protecting the interest of the customers.

### **Creek City Medical Complex**

DHA has decided to setup a Medical Complex spread over 18 acres in Phase-VIII. The concept of independent specialized medical units has not received requisite response. A new proposal of the Creek City Medical Complex (CCMC) is being formalized with the help of experts of health sector to attract investors and create state of art facility to meet the need of the residents.

final stages and the development work on the same would start soon.

Director Special Projects said that DHA was making focused and concerted efforts with a pragmatic and forward looking strategy to ensure early revival/rehabilitation of the stalled DHA Cogen Power & Desalination Plant and that a significant headway had been made in that regard.

PEB asked DSU to maintain highest academic/professional standards in all its programmes, create intellectually stimulating learning environment and to provide best infrastructure facilities at the Campus to ensure credibility and high standing of DSU.

# Annual Budget DHA

#### **Resources Mobilization**

HA Executive Board Meeting chaired by Commander 5 Corps Lt. Gen Muhammad Ijaz Chaudhry, who is also President Executive Board DHA, was held at Headquarters 5 Corps here today. The Executive Board reviewed/evaluated the ongoing development works/mega projects of the Housing Authority and approved the DHA Annual Development Budget for the fiscal year 2012-2013.

Director Finance DHA, Jamal Macdi said that the main objective set forth for the DHA Budget was to ensure speedy completion of the infrastructure development of DHA Phase-VIII focusing on simultaneous development of Sectors C, D and E-8 so as to open them for construction by the next year. The main features of the development works include development of Business Zone, construction of sewerage treatment plants, a new graveyard, road furniture/finishing of roads network of Sec A, B&C and horticulture/landscaping of the area. A sum of Rs. 3 billion has been earmarked for infrastructure development works of Phase-VIII for this fiscal year.

The Executive Board reviewed/

He further added that a sum of Rs. 2 billion had been earmarked for undertaking different development projects in DHA Phase-I to Phase-VII including development/up-gradation of Bokhari Commercial Area on Saba Avenue, DHA Sports Complex (Moin Khan Academy), left over infrastructure development of Phase-VII Extn, installation of electronic surveillance and security

system and a host of other development projects. President Executive Board (PEB) asked the Housing Authority to ensure substantial improvement in the security system in DHA for peaceful living in the area.

Director DHA City Karachi (DCK), Brig (R) Muhammad Rafique highlighted the **DCK** development strategy and said that work on 10 infrastructure development projects including construction of boundary wall, watch towers, entrance gate, access road and office/residential complex was going on speedily which would be completed in one year's time to make the DCK site fully operational. He added that sector development work of two sectors under the short term development plan would start in 3 to 4 months time to make DHA City Karachi a livable place by 2014-15.

PEB DHA directed that alongwith the sector development provision of essential services in DCK like electricity, water and sewerage should be ensured along-with the sector development. He asked DHA authorities that community facilities like schools, masjid, parks and commercial areas etc should also be developed simultaneously.

He said that the projects to be completed in this phase included complete

Engr Arif Osmani said that the water requirement of DHA City Karachi until 2020 was estimated to be 4-5 MGD which would be met through abundance of underground water available in the area. He elaborated that the results of water obtained from groud were very positive and had yielded high quality drinking water having good TDS value.

DCK Chief Consultant, Prof Spiro Pollalis said that the DCK was a sustainable project which was being developed to provide a unique lifestyle to its residents. He added that an international health care city and an international university would also be established at DCK. He reiterated that DCK would be developed as a fully sustainable city with a balanced economy and integrated society.

#### **Environmental Dredging at Gizri Creek**

The Project commenced in March 2007 and was completed in 24 months time period. The Soft Opening of Flyover was held on 15 December 2009. The left over miscellaneous works has now been completed and CBC has been asked to take over the completed project.

# Infrastructure Development of DHA Phase-VIII

### Redesigned in foot step with time

HA Phase-VIII is spread over an area of 4151 acres. It constitutes a small peninsula land reclaimed before allotment of plots. Initial master plan for development of Phase-VIII was made some thirty years back. That plan was rudimentary in nature and there was a need to revisit it since advanced tools made their way in modern day town planning. Thus redesigning was done in 2006. A fresh master plan for infrastructure development of DHA Phase-VIII was accordingly prepared by consultant M/S Osmani & Co. Based



on the new development strategy the development work is being implemented in true letter and spirit. There are six Sectors in Phase-VIII (A to E and E8). In Sector A infrastructure development work is completed and the Sector is open for construction. This includes carpeting road, sewerage, water supply and electrical works including streetlights. Beach



Avenue, which is the main artery linking Seaview with Creek Marina along the beach has been completed by FWO as per international standards and is open for traffic. Water supply main pipelines have been laid between Qasim Pumping Station to DA Country & Golf Club for horticultural purposes.

All infrastructure works of Zulfiqar Commercial Area in Sector A have been completed. Area has been opened for construction. A large network of arterial and collector roads is in progress by NLC. Beside the road works, drainage works have been completed. Finishing works of 16th Street being the primary access to Creek Vistas has been completed at fast pace. Sector A of Phase-VIII has already been opened for construction of



houses. Sector B developments have also been completed and plot owners have been allowed to start the construction of houses. Infrastructure Development of Sector A & B including roads carpeting, sewerage, water supply, electric works including street lights have been completed.

Construction of major arterial roads in entire Ph-VIII (RD 03-08) is also completed.

Infrastructure Development Works in Sector-C includes Sewerage, Water Supply System, Storm Water Drains, Roads and Road Furniture. Infrastructure Development work in Sector-C commenced in May 2011. 4x Contracts have been concluded and present progress is 70%.

Infrastructure Development Works Sector-D includes Sewerage, Water Supply System, Storm Water Drains, Roads and Road Furniture. Work of







rotection of "Environment" is the greatest challenge for the Human race of 21st Century. Horticulture Directorate DHA made hectic efforts to improve the deteriorating environment conditions of Karachi and DHA in particular. DHA plays its role in this noble cause of saving Environment from pollution. Parks, Beautification Spots, Green Belts and Road Medians in DHA have not only provided aesthetic delight to the people of Karachi but also have a soothing and healthy effect on their nerves.

To overcome the acute water shortage, the main problems in Karachi, Horticulture Directorate of DHA had done various successful experiments e.g. use of recycled sewerage water and raw sewerage



water for irrigation purposes and developed some of the best parks in Karachi like Nisar Shaheed Park, Zamzama Park, Major Khalid Shaheed Park, Capt Raja Farhan Sheed Park, McDonald / Seaview Park.

In addition to the existing work some of the new, Parks and Beautification Projects undertaken

by Horticulture Department DHA are as listed below:-

### Re-Development Of Quaid-E-Azam House Museum Lawns

This simple yet elegant house was built in the waning years of the Nineteenth Century. It came into the Quaid's ownership on 14 August 1943. The house was bought from the Quaid-e-Azam Trust by the Government of Pakistan in February 1985 and renamed as the Quaid-e-Azam House Museum. It was opened to the Public on 25 Nov 1993.

The magnificent limestone building covers 10,241 Sq Yds. All belongings of the Quaid-e-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah have been restored to their original state and are displayed within.

Horticulture Directorate carried out development work for our beloved Quaid's house on the directives of Ex-Commander 5 Corps and with all out support of Administrator DHA as a humble tribute to Father of the Nation.

### Tree Plantation on Mahmoodabad Drain (Phase-VII Extension)

To address the long awaited complaints of the residents of Phase-VII (Extn) for foul smell from the

drain. DHA planted over 2000 trees with almost 100% success rates all along Mahmoodabad Drain. It will have positive change in environment of the area and will reduce the bad smell and also converting the ugly looking Nallah into a beautiful green belt. The Plantation along the drain has saved DHA post plantation efforts / resources for obvious reasons, as no watering would be required.

### Zamzama Park

DHA Tissue Culture Lab can also give training to DHA Residents or Outsiders at nominal charges.

Use about 18" of floss, leaving an inch or two to work with. Gently follow the curves of your teeth. Be sure to clean beneath the gum line, but avoid snapping the floss on the gums.

# Celebrating 21 Years of Enlightening DHA

earned members of society from different walks of life spoke about the role of libraries in the promotion of reading habits among people at the commencement of three-day celebrations of the 21st anniversary of the DHA Central Library (DCL).


Speaking on the occasion, scholar and educationist Sardar Mohammad Ashraf recalled how as a student of class seven in Azad Kashmir he took part in a drive to collect books to start a library in his village school. "We collected some 300 books," he proudly told the audience and wondered if that library still existed.

"In 1967, I came to Karachi – a city which was full of libraries. People used to run after knowledge here. I used to go to the KMC library in Jahangir Park where I got to read six or seven different newspapers everyday. As I was working too while educating myself I relied heavily on such public libraries," he said while lamenting the dying library culture in Karachi now.

"Libraries are the essence of intellectual growth in a country. They give you education and education liberates you. Let us start a promotion fund for libraries. I offer Rs. 50,000 to start this fund," he announced.

"You cannot escape education if you want to make any headway in life," said the former head of the National Reconstruction Bureau of Pakistan, Lt. Gen (R) Syed Tanvir Hussain Naqvi, the chief quest on the occasion.

"You require education not to just get a job, but to do the job. You cannot come up with old solutions to new problems by aping other people's solutions to similar kind of problems," he said.

"You have to think of new ways of dealing with things by knowing old solutions and evolving and developing them."

Ameena Saiyid, managing director of the Oxford University Press, said that the Defence Central Library should become a model to be replicated throughout Pakistan.

"A book is like a time machine. It can take you centuries back and take you centuries ahead into the future as well. We can get different perspectives on a subject from books. That way we can never be brainwashed," she said.

"We publish 300 books every year, but we

cannot expect the people to buy all our books. It is important to read new publications too, so if there was a network of libraries, they could house the new books for the public to be able to borrow the books," she added.

Giving his own example, senior journalist Ghazi Salahuddin said that he got most of his education from the British Council library. "With all those books, magazines and good air conditioning, it used to be my refuge," he said before reading out one of his recent columns in which he lamented the lack of reading culture among the affluent, who gave more importance to luxury cars than books, and the absence of good bookshops in brand new shopping centres coming up these days.

"Wedding here cannot take place without jewellery shopping, but lives can be led without books!" he observed.

"You can feel what it is like being other people in other situations even if you have not lived those lives. Books make empathy possible," he concluded.

DCL secretary Lt. Col (R) Rafat Naqvi said that libraries helped unlock minds and that the country needed a network of libraries, but the current situation was very depressing. "The DCL is visited

by most learned people all the time especially after the closing of the British Council and the United States Information Service (USIS) libraries. It is through books that you can have personal contacts with the greatest minds that every lived. When you open a book in the quiet of a library, you enter a new three dimensional world of wisdom and learning," he said.

The three day celebrations included a book fair, storytelling session, Mushaira and an exclusive evening with renowned poet Himayat Ali Shair.

The plan includes random checking of vehicles, nonregistered weapons, drugs, explosives, fake motor registration and tinted glasses in DHA. Another bold feature of this plan is to close down/ seal all political offices in DHA as its Bye-Laws do not permit political activities in residential areas. Display of weapons in DHA is prohibited and will be

> strictly enforced by a joint teams of LEAs who will randomly check such practices.

> For self protection many residents have been provided police / security personnel who have pitched sentry posts and road blocks outside their houses which tantamount to encroachment and is a violation of DHA Bye Laws. LEA teams have been tasked to remove all such road blocks and the concerned residents have been advised to remove such obstructions within one week.

> The Housing Authority has planned electronic surveillance of the entire DHA which is being implemented in phases. In Phase-I of the plan, all entry / exit points of DHA are being monitored through cameras from a Control Room, appropriately linked with suitably located LEA teams for quick reaction / response

# Workshop on Strategic Management Training: DHA

two day workshop session on 'Strategic Management Training in Effective Leadership' was conducted by Prof Dr Emanuel Kondylis of University of Athens, Greece for DHA management at Defence Authority Club.

The workshop was designed to equip the participants with the knowledge of contemporary leadership techniques and to give them an insight of human psychology and its impact on human behavior for enhancing the effectiveness and efficiency of any organization.

The Greek Professor said that efficiency of employees/staff of any organization was dependent on the degree of satisfaction of human needs rather than the mathematical set of rules. He said that softer values must be promoted in an organization to enhance its productivity and efficacy.

The professor summed up the leadership styles into directive, consultative collaborative and delegating. The most effective and successful leadership style was consultative.

He said that an effective leader should spread the pickles of enthusiasm embodying energy and challenge in the working environment; inspire confidence in staff through sharing information with them and demonstrate integrity by ensuring that the actions match with words.

The professor said that the human behavior was the outcome of three entropic ego states intricately interplaying in a human being in a complex manner. The three ego states comprises of parental ego (nurturing and critical), adult ego (objective and rational stemming from thinking rather than feelings) and the child ego (emotional and uncensored feelings).

He added that the human performance was synergic and depended on IQ of individuals which is the ability and potential to solve technical problems as well as on emotional intelligence which predominantly governs human conduct and behavior. He said that competence and potential of individuals were at full play when their emotional needs were satisfied and the element of fear (for survival/future) was adequately addressed in an organization.

Professor Kondylis emphatically stressed that an effective leader should incessantly give positive strokes envisaging positive and optimistic outlook to his subordinates for creating a productive and healthy environment in an organization. Negative strokes must be avoided as it creates pessimism, hopelessness and negative thinking in employees which consequently curb their initiative and performance.

The professor summed up the leadership styles into directive, consultative, collaborative and delegating. The most effective and successful leadership style was consultative.

The thought provoking and informative workshop session was largely attended by the directors and top management of DHA.

# In the Line of Duty

# **Charles Dickens**

- A Prolific Novelist of English Literature

harles Dickens, an English novelist, whose bicentenary celebrations are being cherished round the world, was born on 7th Feb 1812. Dicken's books remain the corner stone of English literature, as a prolific 19th century author of short stories, plays, novels, fiction and nonfiction; he became known the world over for his remarkable characters, his mastery of prose, and his depictions of the social classes, moves and values of his times.





Some of his famous works including Bleak House, A Christmas Carol, David Copperfield, Great Expectations, No Thorough fare, Oliver Twist, The Battle of life, The Pickwick Papers and many more fiction and nonfiction writings are a valuable treasure in the world of English Literature.

### Extracts from some of his famous Novels.

### **Great Expectation**

In the marshy mists of a village churchyard, a tiny orphan boy named Pip is suddenly terrified by a shivering, limping convict on the run. He was living with his sister





husband without any expectations. It and her is only when he begins to visit a rich old woman, Miss Havisham and her adopted niece that he begins to hope for something better. When it is revealed that Pip has inherited a large sum of money from a mysterious benefactor on the condition that he moves to London to become a gentleman, Pip's adventure really begins. Years later, a supremely arrogant young Pip boards the coach to London where, by the grace of a mysterious benefactor, he will join the ranks of the idle rich and "become a gentleman." Finally, in the luminous mists of the village one evening, Pip meets Estella, his dazzlingly beautiful tormentor, in a ruined garden and lays to rest all the heartaches and illusions that his great expectations have brought upon him.

### **Bleak House**

Bleak House opens in a London shrouded by an all pervading fog – a fog that swirls about the Court of Chancery, where the case of Jarndyce and Jarndyce lies lost in endless litigation. This drawn out lawsuit over an inheritance stands at the center of a scathing portrayal of a moribund legal system and of a society permeated with greed, deception, delusion, and guilt. Geoffery Tillotson writes: "Bleak House .... is, all told, the finest literary work the nineteenth century produced in England ...Dickens was the supreme literary genius of his time.

### **Oliver Twist**

Oliver Twist, a meek, mild young boy, is born in the workhouse and spends his early years there until, finding the audacity to ask for more food, he is made to leave.

### **PERISCOPE**

Apprenticed to an undertaker by Mr Bumble, Oliver runs away in desperation and falls in with Fagin and his gang of thieves where he begins his new life in the criminal underworld. With its terrifying evocation of the hypocrisy of the wealthy and the depths to which poverty pushes the human spirit, Oliver Twist is both a fascinating examination of evil and a poignant moving novel for all times.

### The Pickwick Papers

The Pickwick Papers is the remarkable first novel that made its author famous and has remained one of the best known books in the world. In it the inimitable Samuel Pickwick, his well-fed body and unsinkable good spirits clad in tights and gaiters, sallies forth through the noisy streets of London and into the colorful country inns of rural England for a picaresque series of sparkling encounters with love and misadventure. The Pickwick Papers reels with joyous fantasy, infectious good humor, and a touch of the macabre - a classic work that G.K. Chesterton called "the great example of everything that made Dickens great ...a supreme masterpiece."

### **David Copperfield**

Of all Dickens's novels, David Copperfield most fervently embraces the comic delights, the tender warmth, and the tragic horrors of childhood. It is our classic tale of growing up, an enchanting story of a gentle orphan discovering life and love in an indifferent adult world. Persecuted by his wrathful stepfather, Mr. Murdstone; deceived by his boyhood idol, the callous, charming steerforth; driven into moral combat with the sniveling clerk Uriah Heep; and hurled, pell-mell, into a blizzard of infatuation with the adorably dim-witted Dora, he survives the worst - and the best - with inimitable style, his bafflement turning to self awareness and his unbridled young heart growing ever more disciplined and true.

Although Dicken's career as a novelist received much attention, he produced hundreds of essays and edited and rewrote hundreds of others submitted to the various periodicals he edited. Dickens would always be remembered as one of the finest novelist of English literature.

# Significance of Friday (Zohar) prayer in Islam

The Messenger of Allah (Peace be upon him) said, we are the best (with respect to time) but the first (with respect to excellence). Those other people who followed us after it were the Jews tomorrow (Saturday) and the Christians day after tomorrow (Sunday). In another

version of this Hadith (Recorded by Al-Bukhari and Muslim), the Prophet (Peace be upon him) said, we will be the first to enter in Paradise (Recorded by Muslim).

Abu Huraira reported that the Prophet (Peace be upon him) said, "The best day upon which the sun rises is Friday on that day Hazrat Adam Alehsalam was born and was entered into Paradise (Jannat) and on that day he was expelled from Paradise. And the hour (Qayiamat) will only be established on Friday" (Recorded by Muslim). Ibn Al-Arabi points out that the matters mentioned are part of the superiority of Friday. Hazrat Adam Alehsalam expulsion from Paradise is the cause behind the existence of his descendents and of the Prophets and Messengers sent after him. Islamic scholars say that Hadis demonstrate the excellence of Friday and point out the great events that have occured on that day in order to encourage people to do good deeds on Friday and save themselves from Allah punishment

# **Develop your Imagination for Creative Living**



he great key to success in any career is the gift of creative imagination. It is an invaluable practical asset. With it you may raise to any height, without it you are doomed to mediocrity. The lives of great men in any walk of life are characterized by the exercise of this gift. An imaginative solution involves courage as well as insight. You cannot get ideas like that if you insist on remaining in a rut. To be creative you must be dissatisfied with the usual and mediocre, and willing to see new angles and to cultivate a fresh and original attack on your problems.

Originality is the key to success. Perhaps you do not need to be violently different, but you need to deviate from the norm in accordance with your own talents, personality and perceptions. To deviate successfully from the norm, it is first essential to know your subject thoroughly.

If the mind is well trained and well stocked the pressure of responsibility will produce the right ideas. It must be remembered, however, that so many intuitions of genius have come at times of relaxation.

To attempt to be original without really knowing your subject would be to risk the rebuke given by a certain professor to his student after reading his essay. "Yes," he remarked, "it is both new and beautiful, but that which is new is not beautiful, and that which is beautiful is not new." We must first serve our apprenticeship. There is no way of avoiding the preliminary hard work. Every artist must sedulously sit at the feet of his great predecessors and copy his models. Every musician must first work on conventional lines. Then, when he knows what he is doing he may deviate. It is along the line of well-developed interest that imaginative inspiration comes. Choose and know your field. Then sow it with the seed of the crop you wish to reap. The seed



of new ideas is facts in your particular line; these are the concrete things upon which your imagination can work to produce the crop of fresh ideas.

If the mind is well trained and well stocked the pressure of responsibility will produce the right ideas. It must be remembered, however, that so many intuitions of genius have come at times of relaxation. Mozart used to knock the billiards balls about by himself and his tunes would come into his head.

If you want to create original ideas, you may have to train yourself first to be a deviationist in small things. Talk to your wife at breakfast instead of reading the newspaper. Doubtless she will appreciate the change and you have begun the day in a new way. Go to work by a different route, eat at a fresh place, and try some new kinds of food. Watch the figures of speech you habitually use and try to alter them for the better. Learn another language; there is no shorter cut to new thinking. Learn to play an instrument. This is all work that involves patience and effort. But it will, if persisted in, give a zest and a new outlook which could make you feel years younger and give you almost a new life.

Be determined not to stay in a rut but to become a constructive deviationist. You will not need to bother about being original. Be yourself and you will be!

# **Dengue Awareness Note**

engue (pronounced DENGE-gay) can affect anyone but tends to be more severe in people with compromise immune systems. Dengue hemorrhagic fever is a severe, often fatal. There is no specific treatment for dengue. Prevention centers on avoiding mosquito bites in areas where dengue occurs or might occur and eliminating breeding sites. fever. The illness can last up to 10 days, but complete recovery can take as long as a month. Older children and adults are usually sicker than young children.

### How is dengue diagnosed?

Dengue is diagnosed by a blood test.

### What are the signs and symptoms of dengue fever and dengue haemorrhagic fever?

Dengue fever usually starts suddenly with a high fever, rash, severe headache, pain behind the eyes and muscles and joint pain. The severity of the joint pain has given dengue the name "break bone fever". Nausea, vomiting and loss of appetite are common. A rash usually appears 3 to 4 days after the start of the

### What is the treatment for dengue and dengue haemorrhagic fever?

There is no specific treatment for dengue. Persons with dengue fever should rest and drink plenty of fluids. They should be kept away from mosquitoes for the protection of others. Dengue hemorrhagic fever is treated by replacing lost fluids. Some patients need transformation to control bleeding.
