By their grand ambience and spiritual exuberance, they beckon you to show your reverence for the Almighty and bow your heads in gratitude five times a day.






President Executive Board (PEB) further said that provision of secure and safe environment to the

SMALL IS THE BIG IDEA


BONSAI

One window, many doors. Introducing the CCC!



People can now find the representations of DHA, CBC and MEO under one roof, providing all assistance pertaining to the completion of building plan formalities — from the silt to the skyscraper, from sandcastles to real estate castles.

The one window operation provides a great relief to the residents and has drastically curtailed the processing time to half.

The human bricks who, put together, become a fortress of trust-and sense of security-for residents and visitors alike, DHA Vigilance is always alert to any unforeseen situation.

Tasked with the onerous responsibility of ensuring across-the-board implementation of DHA by-laws and to provide secure living evironment in the area, assist the law-enforcement agencies in random checking of vehicles, unregistered weapons, drug abuse, indecent exposures, fake motor registration and any situation going haywire in DHA, the department is fully geared with state-of-the-art electronic cameras which have been installed at all exit and entrance points, focal venues and

commercial areas for electronic surveillance.

DHA Vigilance has recently been expanded and modernised to enhance its efficacy and to make it an effective force that can assist the police in enhancing security and safety in DHA.

DHA along with the police has formed a taskforce with six vans and 10 motorcycles to keep a check on criminal activities in the area and to promptly and effectively deal with any untoward incident within DHA. And with check posts and road blockades in different focal spots, you can't miss the point of having them around you like watchful "eyes and ears".

ASSOCIATION OF DEFENCE RESIDENTS MEETS DHA ADMINISTRATOR

A delegation of the Association of Defence Residents (ADR) led by its President Mr Attiqueur-Rehman visited DHA and held a meeting with Administrator DHA, Brig Muhammad Abdullah, at DHA Main Office to discuss various issues related to the residents.

The Administrator underlined the need for positive interaction between DHA and residents' associations. He said that for DHA, satisfaction of residents was of utmost importance and DHA would always welcome the valuable feedback from the residents' associations.

The delegation was informed that the leftover development works in DHA Phase-VII and Phase-VII Extension were under progress and will be

completed soon. The Administrator told them that recently DHA has started development of Sec 'E' in Phase-VIII which was the only leftover sector and the work is undergoing at a fast pace.

The Administrator reiterated that DHA accorded highest priority to provision of secure and safe living environment to residents. He said that DHA has formulated a security plan to improve the overall security situation in the Housing Authority and in this regard major steps will be taken soon.

The meeting concluded on a positive note, while both residents and DHA officials expressed their resolve to continue meaningful cooperation in future.

Improving EFFICACY

DRS MEETS DHA ADMINISTRATOR



A meeting of DRS with Administrator DHA is in progress at the DHA Main Office

A representative delegation of Defence Residents' Society (DRS) led by its President Zafar Iqbal visited DHA Main Office and held a meeting with Administrator DHA Brig Muhammad Abdullah to discuss various problems of the residents. DHA officials concerned were also present.

Brig Abdullah reiterated that interactions between DHA management and residents' representatives help the Housing Authority to formulate a realistic development strategy. He also apprised the forum that Defence Housing Authority was taking a number of proactive measures to improve the security environment in DHA which also include establishment of a "DHA Security Company" to curtail the street crime.

DRS delegation complemented DHA for introducing One Way Traffic Regime on Khayaban-e-Shamsheer and was of the view that the new system has greatly helped in smooth regulation of the traffic going to Seaview and back.

The delegation was informed that work on various development projects in DHA City Karachi (DCK) was in full swing to make DCK a livable entity by 2015-16. It was also stated that infrastructural development works in different sectors of DHA Phase-VIII were being completed on a fast track

basis and that major portion of the development budget in Phase-VIII was dedicated to completing the electrification and gasification schemes in the area.

VC DHA Suffa University said that the newly established institution of higher learning was being developed as a world class University of Engineering and Management Sciences. Chief Engineer apprised the forum that work on development of a new graveyard in DHA Phase-VIII is being undertaken by FWO and would be completed soon.

Director Building Control responding to a DRS suggestion to simplify the DHA Building Rules/Regulations said that computerised AutoCAD based system was being introduced in DHA to simplify the procedure. He said that at Central Control Cell (CCC) established at DHA Main Office, the time for completion of Building Plan has been reduced considerably.

President DRS thanked Administrator DHA and his team and assured him of the full cooperation and support of the Association. Later the DRS delegation visited the Central Control Cell and appreciated the efficacy and role of the set up.

KEEPING Vigil




Administrator DHA Brig Muhammad Abdullah addressed a largely attended gathering of DHA Vigilance personnel at Central Library DHA recently.

The Administrator asked the Vigilance staff to prepare themselves to deal with the new emerging challenges with a reinvigorated and dynamic approach. He said that Vigilance Department was the only uniformed force in DHA and therefore it was expected that they would maintain highest standard of discipline, efficiency and excellence in all their undertakings. He said that it was obligatory on Vigilance Staff to win the confidence and trust of residents through their exemplary professional-cum-personal conduct.

Brig Abdullah reminded the DHA personnel of their onerous responsibilities to ensure across the board implementation of DHA byelaws and to provide best security in the area. He said that the country was passing through a very critical stage of its history whereas terrorism, bomb blasts and heinous crimes were rampant in the metropolis. He asked the Vigilance Staff to remain extra vigilant and to adopt proactive strategy for facing the onslaught of challenges effectively.

The Administrator said that DHA Vigilance has recently been expanded and modernised to enhance its efficacy and to make it an effective force which could augment police and other law enforcement agencies in enhancing security and safety environment in DHA. He said that electronic surveillance of DHA has been ensured by installing surveillance/electronic cameras and that Vigilance has been provided more vehicles and modern equipment/weapons to enhance its efficacy and effectiveness.


Director Security and Vigilance DHA and other DHA officials also attended.

There is the Defence Authority Country & Golf Club; one of the finest golfing resorts in the country having a professional 18-hole golf course.



DSU is recognised by the Higher Education Commission of Pakistan (HEC) as a private sector degree awarding university in the province of Sindh. The BE (Mechanical) and BE (Electrical) programs of DSU are approved by the Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC). The BS (Computer Science) program conforms to the standards of National Computing Education Accreditation Council (NCEAC), whereas the BBA and MBA programs conform to the standards of National **Business Education Accreditation Council** (NBEAC). The University was inspected and evaluated by the Sindh Government's Charter Inspection and Evaluation Committee (CIEC) to its full satisfaction on 26th December 2012 and was awarded an overall five star excellent rating.

Collaboration with Foreign Universities

From its very inception, DHA Suffa University has envisioned to be a globally recognised and world renowned academic institution. As part of this strategy, DHA Suffa University signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Technical University of Applied Sciences (TUAS), Wildau, Germany in February 2014 to establish

collaboration in academics and research. TUAS-Wildau has strong academic and research programs in the areas of Engineering, Information Technology, Bio Technology, Bio Informatics, Renewable Energy, Logistics and Management Sciences. Therefore, there is a potential for great synergy between DSU and TUAS-Wildau. Under the MoU, students of DSU will be able to attend one or two semesters for studies at TUAS-Wildau and perform an industrial internship in Germany, arranged by TUAS-Wildau. Other collaboration envisaged by the MoU includes exchange of faculty members, technology transfer for industries, businesses and enterprises, specialised summer camps tailored to DSU requirements and launching of joint degree programs. The MoU with TUAS-Wildau follows an earlier MoU, the University signed with the Eurasia Institute of International Education (EIIE) also located in Berlin for the establishment of a German Resource Centre at DSU to impart training in German language to DSU students and others to facilitate the exploitation of educational, industrial and research opportunities provided by German institutions and industries.

DSU is already reaping the benefits of an MoU signed earlier in May 2013, with the AIMST University (formerly The Asian Institute of Medicine, Science & Technology), Penang, Malaysia, to promote collaboration in academics and research. The MoU is facilitating student and faculty mobility programs and cooperation in academic programs and research. Both the institutions are benefiting immensely from this MoU in a win-win situation.

Scholarships

Scholarships are part of DSU's commitment to rewarding academic excellence and enabling students from all backgrounds to realise their potential, graduate with strong practical skills and achieve their goals. DSU awards need-based and merit-based scholarships every semester to deserving students.

DSU Campus

The present campus of DHA Suffa University spreads over 5 acres of land in the secure and safe environment of Phase VII (Ext) in DHA, Karachi. Master planning to build a self-contained campus, comprising high rise buildings over 25 acres of land at DHA City, has been done by M/S Osmani and Company Limited. It will accommodate 5500 students, 350 faculty and 1000 NTS, in the 1st Phase. Expansion of DSU Campus in Phase II over 200 acres of land in DHA City is also planned.

Faculty

DSU boasts of a highly accomplished full time faculty, who are actively engaged in teaching as well as research activities. Located in DHA Phase-VIII, here you can haggle over the best household items, grocery, crockery, books, clothes and all things big and small; whatever walk of life you come from.







FAST Forward

DEVELOPMENT

DHA Phase-VIII is spread over an area of 4,151 acres which is 50% of DHA. It constitutes a small peninsula land reclaimed before allotment of plots. Initial master plan for development of Phase-VIII was made some thirty years back. That plan was rudimentary in nature and there was a need to revisit it since advancement of tools and their way in modern day town planning have to be kept in mind. Thus redesigning was done in 2006.

A fresh master plan for infrastructure development of DHA Phase-VIII was accordingly prepared by Consultant M/s Osmani & Co in 2006 based on the development strategy which is being implemented in true letter and spirit.

There are six sectors in Phase-VIII (A to E and E8). In Sector A, B, C & E-8 development work is completed. This includes road carpeting, sewerage, water supply and electrical works including street lights. Sectors A & B are open for construction.

ONGOING PROJECTS

Sewerage Treatment Plant (STP)

This project includes Design, Build Operate and Maintenance of 2.4MGD Sewerage Treatment Plant. Construction works of STP was started on 07 May 2013 and is likely to be completed by 06 May 2014. Cost of the project is approximately 498M. The overall progress of the project is 50%





Infrastructure Development Works D-South

Infrastructure development works in Sector D-South includes Storm Water Drains, Roads and Road Furniture and Construction of Graveyard and a pumping station. Work of infrastructure development in Sector D-South commenced on 23 May 2013 and is likely to be completed on 22 Nov 2014. Cost of the project is 1592.82M. The overall progress of the project is 26%.





Infrastructure Development Works D-North

Infrastructure development works in Sector D-North includes Roads, Kerb Blocks, Sewerage System, Water Supply, Storm Water Drain, Utility Chambers and Pipe Sleeves. Work of infrastructure development in Sector D-South commenced on 23 May 2013 and is likely to be completed on 22 Nov 2014. Cost of the project is 1162.43M. The overall progress of the project is 57%.





Business Zone

This project includes Roads, Pipe Sleeves, Utility Chambers, Storm Water Drain, Kerb Block, Sewerage System and Water Supply System. Infrastructure development works in Business Zone was started on 10 Apr 2013 and is likely to be completed on 09 May 2014. Cost of the project is approximately 291.47M. The overall progress of the project is 57%.





Defence Avenue (RD-16)

This project includes Roads, Pipe Sleeves, Utility Chambers, Storm Water Drain, Kerb Block, Sewerage System and Water Supply System. Infrastructure development works in Defence Avenue was started on 10 Apr 2013 and is likely to be completed on 09 May 2014. Cost of the project is approximately 296M. The overall progress of the project is 58%.





New Milestones

In Jan 2014 development work under two new projects has commenced which includes Sector-E (South), inaugurated by Commander 5 Corps Lt Gen Sajjad Ghani, HI (M) on 20 Jan 2014 and Sector-E (North) was inaugurated by Administrator DHA, Brig Muhammad Abdullah on 03 Feb 2014. The works are in their initial stage.





Conclusion

Infrastructural development works in DHA Phase-VIII are being done on fast track basis and as per the timelines set forth. All major development works are planned to be completed in next 1-2 years.




Safe and clean environment is a byproduct of a healthy mindset, and DHA is fully aware of its responsibilities as a health-conscious corporate citizen.


DHA City Karachi was conceived to become Pakistan's first green sustainable and smart city with contemporary architecture coupled with sublime infrastructure having state-of-the-art modern hi-tech facilities. The master planning for the City began in 2011 and in about a year's time it was completed.

Execution started in 2012. The meticulous master plan of the area includes residential, commercial & recreational facilities. The whole master plan approach for this new city of roughly 11,640 acres is focused on Sustainable Design Principles. The plans utilise the planning principles behind the Ekistics theory presented by the legendary planner Mr. Constantinos Doxiadis.

This theory promotes the concept of mixed use residential sectors by creating multiple centres within them spreading facilities such as commerce, amenities and parks throughout these areas.

DCK has a dedicated healthcare and higher education institutes, theme parks, a convention centre, informal and formal sports with recreational facilities and resorts, restaurants along with all essential neighbourhood facilities. At the core of the new city lies the City Gateway and Downtown district. Due considerations have been given to the distribution of land uses within this area in order to provide a vital economic and cultural heart that will support the city as it grows.

The master plan is completed through an extraordinary exercise involving more than 100 national and international experts using latest international standards and GIS technology. DCK will be the first Sustainable City in Pakistan, and will bring both DCK and Pakistan on the international map of sustainable cities development. The master plan encounters community centres, gateway district, downtown business zones, downtown market, education zone, golf club resort, Lake View Park, wind and solar energy parks, sports centre and facilities, and theme park.



The principle behind the master plan is a group of selfsustaining cities within a city, with all community amenities accessible to every resident within a 10minute walk. The business district will be provided with a car-free pedestrian walkway with greenery on both sides, garden courtyards, water features and piazzas. This is aimed at promoting the public movement and interaction to improve the quality of life in the business district. This will increase communication between employees, visitors and residents. An efficient public transportation system will help to support this. The City is further divided into 16 sectors, each sector having its own blend of self-sustaining mixed land use. Each sector is laced with latest hi-tech information and communication system with a fool proof localised security and surveillance system. The City is also designed to have its own health care facilities, a central business district, golf course and international standard theme parks.

The downtown zone provides an immense opportunity for business sector. It encounters city gateway with an area of 306 acres, culture and art sub-district with an area of 49 acres, education sub-district and central business sub-district with an area of 103 acres each, central market sub-district with an area of 96 acres and mixed use sub-district with an area of 101 acres. State-of-the-art structures have been developed for colleges, universities and expo-centres.








Development work under way in Sector 7 at DHA City Karachi











The Neuplex in Defence Housing Authority Phase VIII claims to house the biggest cinema screens in the country.

Located in an entertainment centre, called "The Place" in Khayaban-e-Shaheen, the complex has five theatre halls – Cinema 1 has 270 seats, Cinema 2 has 360 seats, Cinema 3 has 275 seats, Cinema 4 has 148 seats and Cinema 5, which is a luxury theatre hall, has 48 seats.

All five halls support 3D projection. The screens in Nueplex range from 50 to 60 feet and are the first one-piece silver screens of this size ever installed in Pakistan, all spread edge to edge.

Technically speaking, everything down to the

viewing angle and decibel level of the seats in Nueplex is calculated to the last detail.

The complex has ample parking space, best franchises in town in terms of food and the best audio and visual experience along with a wide selection of films that the audience love to watch. As things go, The Place is "the place" to be in, where you may find all sorts of family entertainment plans for members of all ages.

A medium-sized car racing track for children which is safe and fun to negotiate their speeding formula car miniature models, a beautiful merry-go-round for kids to "horse around" and a towering "drop" that will let you fall to ground zero in seconds even before you can catch your breath!



Two wind-masts have also been installed at DCK for recording the wind data to be utilised for generation of renewable wind energy. Planning for development of solar energy and independent power generation is also afoot, with a view to making DCK self-sufficient in energy requirements. There is abundance of high-quality underground water to meet DCK's water needs.

The local community also benefits with the mega-







ICT Initiatives



Use of technologies in today's world is reshaping businesses, lives of nations and peoples. In order to remain adept with the advancing world and contribute as a net-centric organisation, DHA Karachi has undertaken a number of ICT initiatives focusing on a paradigm shift in its existing processes; making them smarter, more efficient and customer-oriented.

The major milestones achieved during past one year include development of state-of-the-art database management systems using latest technology, business specific applications software along with automation of routine office functions. Data security with quick response time is the hallmark of all these milestones.

Various achievements and projects include:

DHA Website

In order to facilitate DHA Karachi members and general public, a dynamic and informative website accessible at has been made available. The website provides information to DCK members regarding their plot numbers with payment details, various DHA Projects, Services, Job Opportunities, Tenders and Press Releases which are published from time to time. The website can be accessed 24/7.

eBallot System

An eBallot System has been developed to bring in transparency and visibility in plots ballot. The eBallot System has successfully gone through a major balloting event on 23 April 2013 for DHA City plot owners.

Database Management & Information Security

Following best practices, comprehensive security parameters have been implemented to safeguard and maintain the sanctity of data. The security parameters have been built into the system to allow only the authorised users to access required information. Also the properties database has been upgraded to latest technology with enhanced security and quick response time. This is being monitored and upgraded on regular basis.

Business Specific Applications

The processes of key business areas have been reengineered to make them smarter, more efficient and paperless. Focus has been on removing redundancy, avoiding time delays and physical file movement.

In order to achieve this, applications software have been developed to automate Transfer & Record (T&R), Town Planning & Building Control (TP&BC), Financials and Office Correspondence functions.

Document Archiving

All key documents in each property file have been digitised and made available to the authorised users within DHA Network. This has reduced time and restricted physical movement of file during verification / scrutiny of properties. Archiving is a continuous activity and for this purpose a Digital Archiving Centre is being established.

Automated SMS / Email Service

DHA Karachi has deployed automated bulk SMS / email service to keep its members informed / updated regularly regarding their properties.

ICT Infrastructure

DHA Karachi is in the process of upgrading its ICT infrastructure in line with the best practices being followed in the world. The ICT infrastructure will include the state-of-the-art datacentre, networks and communication infrastructure that will also bring all auxiliary setups and CCTV Surveillance system in its ambit.
